### NOTES AND CONDITIONS

1. Admissions by programme: £5.00 adults, £2.00 children/OAPs. (£2.50/£1.00 return for those leaving after the first session)
2. The length of the Pool is 25 metres. Individual events are 50 metres (two lengths) and swimmers will need to be able to turn within the rules for each stroke they swim.
3. INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: swimmers will need to sign in for every event swim. Age is as on day of meet and minimum age is 9 years.
4. RELAY EVENTS: Coaches or team managers are asked to declare the members of relay teams at the start of each session, by writing the swimmers' names on a team declaration form (which will be available to them on arrival) and returning it to the recorder's table at the start of the relevant session.
5. COACHES' PASSES: coaches will only be permitted on the poolside with official Meet Passes.
5. CAMERAS: in line with ASA policies on child protection, any camera used during the meet, including mobile phone cameras, must be registered in the book provided.
7. Swimmers are not to enter the water in the Teaching Pool at any time during the Meet.
8. Swimmers are not permitted in the spectator seating area with bare feet or only in swimwear.
9. All finalists should proceed immediately after their swim to the area around the teaching pool, from where they will be directed to receive presentations on the poolside.
10. Awards will be made to all finalists who complete their swim without being disqualified, with medals for the first, second and third places and pennants for fourth, fifth and sixth place.
11. Trophies will be awarded for Best Boy and Best Girl in each age group and there will be a separate relay teams award.
12. The Rotary Club of Lewisham Cup will be awarded to the Best Club.
13. The Meet Manager is Mr Keith Bagnall.
