First rounds - heat declared basis - i.e. no finals - will be swum in **TWO** separate sessions at Medway Park Gillingham on Saturday 26th March, 2011.

**1<sup>st</sup> session – 11.00 am. warm up for 11.30 am start**

Schools in WEST KENT and MEDWAY (Dartford, Gravesham, Sevenoaks, Tonbridge & Malling, Tunbridge Wells) + All MEDWAY SCHOOLS & L.B BROMLEY & L.B. BEXLEY

**2<sup>nd</sup> Session - 2.30 p.m. warm up for 3.00 p.m. start.**

Schools in EAST and MID KENT (Canterbury, Dover, Thanet, Ashford, Maidstone, Shepway) and SWALE and Small Schools (individuals and relays)

NB The fastest **6** individuals and the fastest **6** teams from each round (excluding the small schools) will go on to the Final round at Medway Park on Saturday 2nd April 2011 - 1.30 p.m. warm up for 2.00p.m. start

- Event 1. Mixed 4 x 1 length Medley Relay Competition. ( 3 boys, 1 girl, or 2 boys, 2 girls, or 3 girls, 1 boy) For years 3 - 6 Swimming order – Backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly, freestyle  
N.B. this event will only be swum in the first round and is not included in selection for inter-county gala.  
Medals will be awarded to the first six teams at each session.

- Event 10. Boys 4 x 1 length Mixed Stroke Relay. For pupils in years 5 and 6 only **Swimming order backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly or breaststroke, freestyle.**
- Event 11. Girls 4 x 1 length Mixed Stroke Relay. For pupils in years 5 and 6 only **Swimming order backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly or breaststroke, freestyle**
- Event 12 Small Schools Freestyle Relay . For years 5 and 6 only - 4 boys or 4 girls or any combination of both for schools with no more than a combined total of 50 pupils in years 5 and 6.. Competitors in this event may NOT compete in the boys and girls mixed stroke and freestyle relays N.B. THIS EVENT WILL BE SWUM IN THE 2nd SESSION ON 26th March ON A HEAT DECLARED WINNER BASIS. TOP THREE WILL QUALIFY FOR THE INTERCOUNTY ROUND BUT WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE FINALS GALA.
- Event 13 Boys 4 x 1 length Freestyle Relay - for pupils in years 5 and 6 only
- Event 14 Girls 4 x 1 length Freestyle Relay. For pupils in years 5 and 6 only.
- Event 15 Small Schools Mixed Stroke Relay. For years 5 and 6 only - 4 boys or 4 girls or any combination of both for schools with no more than a combined total of 50 pupils in years 5 and 6. Competitors in this event may NOT compete in the boys and girls mixed stroke and freestyle relays. **N.B. swimming order for this event is Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle (any stroke) Front crawl.** N.B. THIS EVENT WILL BE SWUM IN THE 2nd SESSION ON 26<sup>st</sup> March ON A HEAT DECLARED WINNER BASIS. TOP THREE WILL QUALIFY FOR THE INTERCOUNTY ROUND BUT WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE FINALS GALA.

**Please note that although great care has been taken in planning the running order of these championships some swimmers may find that the events they wish to enter are very close together. It may well be that choices have to be made!**

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL SCHOOLS

Individual swimmers and teams placed 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in the final round will be selected to swim for Kent Schools in the annual inter-county match against Surrey Schools at Guildford Spectrum Leisure Centre on Friday 13th May, 2011. **Teams** placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in that match will then be invited to swim in the National Swimming Championships for Primary Schools in Sheffield on 18<sup>th</sup> June. **TEAMS SELECTED TO SWIM IN THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS MUST CONSIST OF CHILDREN IN YEARS 5 AND 6 ONLY.**

**N.B. The above details do not apply to Event 1 the Mixed Medley Competition which will only be swum in the preliminary rounds.**

DATE: Saturday, 26th March 2011.

VENUE: Medway Park, Mill Road, Gillingham Kent.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) These championships are confined to pupils from Schools in current affiliation with the K.S.S.A.
- 2) All competitors must be on the school role on the day of the Championships.
- 3) Competitors must be 7 years and under 11 years on 31st August/1st September for events 1 – 9 and must be aged 9 years and under 11 years for events 10 - 15 at the commencement of the academic year 2010/2011
- 4) A competitor may enter **ONE** individual event **AND up to three** team events.
- 5) Each school shall be limited to **ONE** competitor per individual event and **ONE** team per team event.
- 6) It is a condition of entry that a teacher or responsible adult accompanies each School's competitors as team manager and must stay with them on the poolside. Only team managers wearing the official badge will be allowed on the poolside and will be entitled to a programme free of charge
- 7) Medals will be awarded in each final event at the discretion of the Executive. No awards will be made to disqualified swimmers.
- 8) Entry fees - £3.50 per each individual event  
£6.00 per each team event
- 9) Entries **MUST** be made on the official entry form.

ENTRY FORMS together with a **STAMPED SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE (if a receipt is required)** must be received by the Swimming Championships Secretary on or before **the last day of February 2011.**

**To alleviate crowding at registration-TEAM MANAGERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN IN their swimmers at the table in the changing area at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of each session.**

**PLEASE NOTE: NO PROGRAMME WILL BE SENT TO THE SCHOOL PRIOR TO THE GALA.**

SUBSTITUTIONS may be made due to ILLNESS OR INJURY ONLY and notice, in writing giving full details of the substitute, should be given the Swimming Championships Secretary not less than 30 minutes before the start of the session. Substitutions may not be made in individual events between rounds.

NB An official photographer may be present during the galas.

Dear Colleague,

The entry forms for the 2011 K.S.S.A. Primary Championships which also incorporates rounds of the National Swimming Championships for Primary Schools. are attached.

Please note that both the preliminary and the final rounds will be at MEDWAY PARK (formerly Black Lion Leisure Centre) Gillingham.

I would draw your attention to the relay events. You will note that the boys and girls medley relays are mixed stroke relays and swimmers on the third leg may swim either butterfly or breaststroke. Generally speaking butterfly is the faster stroke so you may want to take this into consideration when selecting your swimmers. The small schools events are open to single sex teams as well as mixed teams. This means that small single sex schools may enter these events. These events will be on a heat declared winner basis and medals will be awarded on the day. The first three teams will be invited to the annual inter-county match against Surrey on Friday 13th May but will not have to attend the finals gala on 2nd April.

Once again the top six swimmers from each session will qualify for the final round to be held on Saturday, 2nd April 2011
