



## London Swimming 800m/1500m Long Course Time Trials Conditions - 2011

The time trials shall be open to eligible swimmers, as defined by the ASA, who are registered members of clubs affiliated to Essex, Kent, Middlesex and Surrey in whose name they are entered with priority being given to those swimmers from London clubs.

Entries shall be made on the official entry form which must be fully and correctly completed. Entries, accompanied by the appropriate entry fee, shall be received by the Swimming Events Administrator by the specified closing date.

A swimmer's age shall be determined as at midnight on the date of the time trials.

Swimmers in the age bands 12 to 24 must have achieved the entry consideration qualifying time at an event Licensed at Levels 1, 2 or 3 by the ASA or WASA, or Levels 1 or 2 by the SASA, or an event outside of Great Britain with a time on the ASA rankings. The entry time must have been achieved in the 12 months immediately preceding the closing date for the Time Trials. All entry times to be converted by use of the ASA Equivalent Performance Tables. The Events Committee reserves the right to ask for proof of entry time (subsequent improved times will not be accepted). The Events Committee reserves the right to fine clubs £50 for submitting multiple incorrect entries.

Swimmers 25+ must have their times recorded on the ASA rankings. A maximum of 24 entries will be accepted for the 25+ 800m and a maximum of 16 entries will be accepted for the 25+ 1500m.

In the interest of safety and to ensure the smooth running of the meet the Events Committee reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in any event. In such case the swimmers with the faster submitted times in each age group will take preference. The **only** situation where refunds will be given is to entrants who are denied entry because this clause has been exercised.

The 800m event will be swum first.

Swimmers must report and sign in for all events at the registration table at the pool no later than 30 minutes before the advertised session start time. Failure to report shall cancel the swimmer's right to compete, as will failure to report to the competition marshals' prior to an event. Heat start lists for each event will be posted. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure his/her name appears on the list prior to the start time of the session.

There will be no awards.

Any dispute for which the foregoing Conditions do not provide shall be determined by the Events Committee.
