Ladies Challenge Shield Brighton Pier to Pier Swim

2011 course starts from West Pier Beach and ends at finish boat anchored at Brighton (Palace) Pier but exit sea on the beach - NOT on the pier.

Saturday 16th July 2011 at 12.00 midday

In the event of a postponement the race will take place on Saturday 23rd July 2010 at 3.45 pm.

Conditions

1. The race shall be conducted annually under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules by the Brighton Swimming Club (affiliated to ASA SE Region) and shall be open to ladies and girls. Swimmers must be aged 13 years or over on the 16th July 2011.

2. The race shall be a scratch race, open to members of clubs affiliated to the Amateur Swimming Association.

Competitors must be registered with the ASA and must produce their Category 2 registration number.

The race will be swum from the beach adjacent to the old West Pier to the Brighton Pier, a distance of approximately 1056 metres.

3. The Perpetual trophies may be held by the winner(s) from the time of giving satisfactory guarantee until 30 days prior to the date fixed for the next event, or until written demand for return by Brighton S.C. The Perpetual trophies may not be taken out of the country.

4. Entries will be limited to the first 60 names received. The entry fee will be £15.00 and entries should be made on the entry form not later than 4th July 2011.

7. This event will be swum at the same time as the Men's and Boys' Challenge Trophy event, with the ladies starting approximately 5 minutes after the men.
